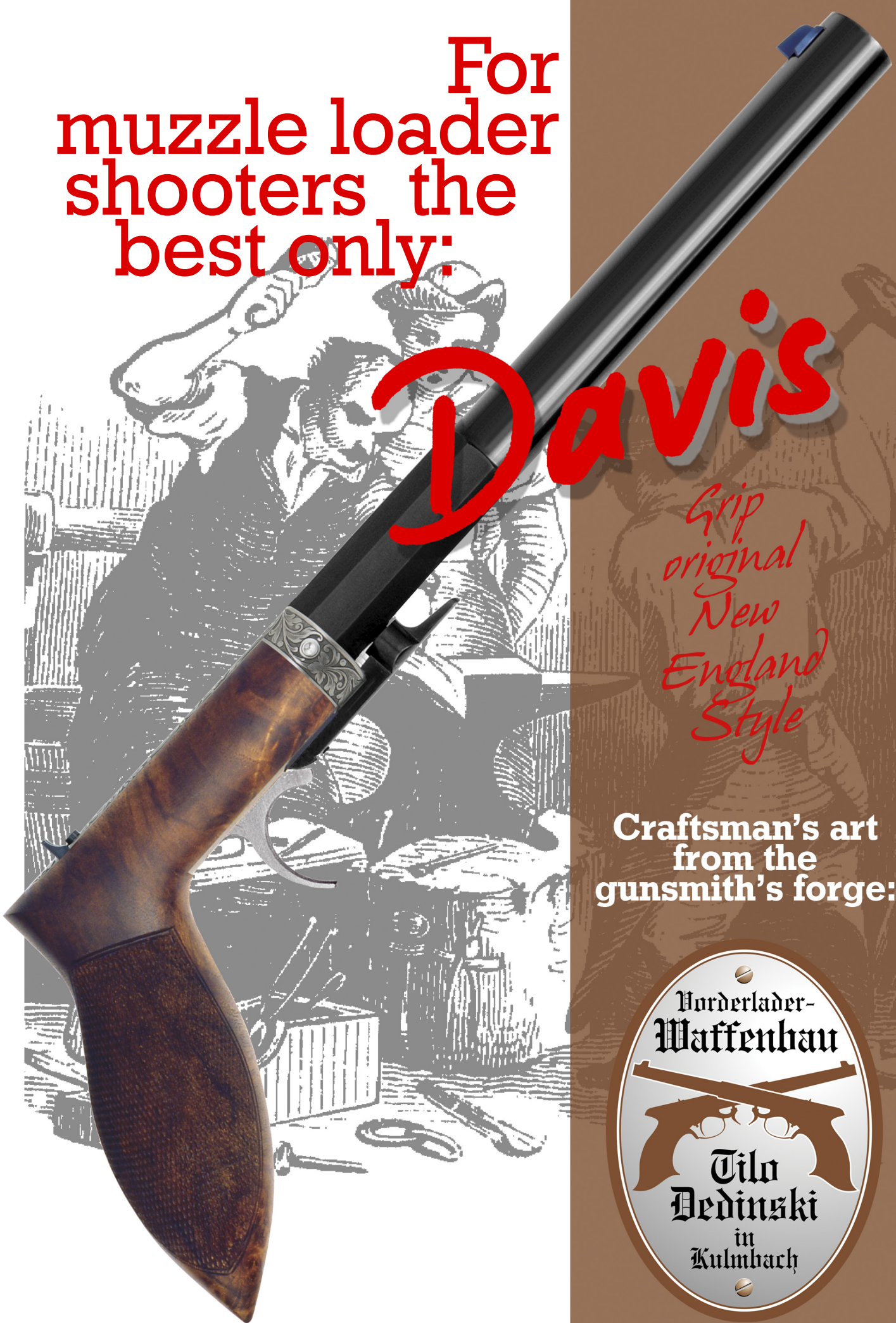

- .36 caliber barrel Suhl made, vacuum tension-free annealed
- Walnut stock
- barrel and hammer blued
- front sight adjustable for windage
- rear sight adjustable for elevation
- nipple with tungsten carbide insert

Technical data:

- length of barrel 230 or 205mm
- sight radius 293mm (230m barrel)
- overall length approx. 394mm (230mm barrel)
- weight approx. 950 g

Included accessories:

- punch to remove the conical pin
- nipple key
- key for adjusting of the recess-overlap
- manual with loading data

Additional charges for:

- .40 / .45 caliber
- grips made out of walnut wood
- individual grip size (trigger distance)
- engravings and gold-inlays
- checkering
